I hope this letter arrives at its destination

and I hear from you.

I am married, have a good wife and two children aged 12 and 15 years. We are healthy and passed the year of the war well. We hope the same about you. We suppose you are married, have a good and children.

Next I want to finish for today, hoping this letter reaches you in the rest of Seattle and Kopenhagen.
